When open moorage spaces do become available interested members need to submit a request for that space. Bids are not carried over from space to space and interested members will need to submit bids each time.
- ◆ **Inspections**—Our last work party for 2011 was Saturday, November 19. Thanks to Robert Grimes and Jim Cadd the boathouse inspections were completed. Members will be notified of any remedies that need to be taken care

of. Chris Erickson has completed the electrical inspection and we (he) is on track to bringing this long term project closer to completion. Thanks to the members that have responded to our requests for keys to boat-houses, we are down to just a few that we still need. All of the fire extinguishers have been checked, recharged and/or hydro tested. We also replaced the boxes for the extinguishers at the last work party.

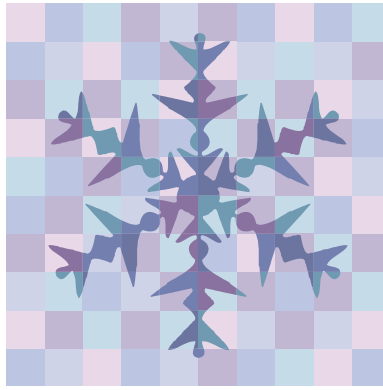
## Monday Night Football
